Laura Heathcote is an in demand violinist performing regularly across the UK. Having studied at the Royal College of Music and the Royal Welsh College of Music, Laura has gone on to perform at no.10 Downing Street, for United Nation summits and at the Royal Albert Hall, amongst other venues. Laura has recorded for the BBC and for worldwide televised adverts and regularly performs at weddings as a soloist and as part of her quartet, the Diamond string quartet.

Since the end of lockdown, Laura has performed regularly for fever events in Bristol and London, performing a daft punk tribute as well as classical concerts, as part of a piano duo.
Other than performing, Laura is in high demand as a violin teacher in the south west.

Stuart Phippen after completing his Honours music degree and winning the Canon Jack Award for Piano Stuart continued his post graduate studies at Trinity College London where he specialised in accompanying, studying piano with Joseph Weingarten and harpsichord with Valda Aveling. On completing his studies he was awarded the Alec Rowley Memorial Prize. Returning to the West country Stuart built a career around teaching and performing.

Stuart's experience and love of music is eclectic from playing cocktail piano, working with Jazz ensembles, Big Bands, pit work for musicals, session work, répétiteur and performing at venues from Wigmore Hall to Hotel de Paris Monte-Carlo. Accompanying has always played a large part in Stuart's professional career which has been rewarded by working with both top international musicians and some very talented young artists through his work in schools
