

**Micaela Núñez** is a Paraguayan guitarist, music graduate, and educator specializing in the Suzuki method. With a background in both classical and folk guitar, her performances are marked by deep sensitivity and a strong connection to Latin American music.

Mica studied at the National Conservatory of Music of Paraguay and earned her degree from the Institute of Fine Arts. She later continued her studies at the National University of Rosario (Argentina), where she worked under renowned masters such as Eduardo Isaac, Eduardo Fernández, and Juan Almada. Micaela has also participated in masterclasses with prominent artists including: Berta Rojas, Edelton Gloeden, Franco Platino, José Carlos Cabrera, Paulo Inda, Thomas Patterson, Víctor Villadangos, and William Kanengiser.

Mica was a member of the "Ensamble Pu Rory" project, directed by Maestra Berta Rojas (a wonderful guitarist that the YMS hosted in 2023 concert, that many of you will no doubt remember), and a recipient of the prestigious Instrumentoteca Toyota programme, for which she was awarded a high-quality concert guitar, and the opportunity to travel to the UK to study and perform in concerts. It is for these reasons that we are fortunate to have Micaela with us to perform at St Mary's Church, Yatton.
