

This AGM concert represents the first concert of the 2026/27 season.

Reminder of YMS Membership Arrangements. Membership runs from 1 June, or whenever you renew it, until the end of the YMS year, which is 31 May. However, anyone who is a member on or before 31 May, is still entitled to vote at the following AGM (normally held in early July), and we encourage members to come and use their vote at the AGM.

Membership can be renewed for next year's concerts any time after 31 May which will allow you to continue to benefit from membership ticket pricing (ie £10). So please do renew your membership as soon as possible after 31 May, via the YMS website or in person at a concert. The AGM concert represents the first concert of the new season and will need a new membership.

Tickets for non-YMS members are currently £15/concert but are only £10/concert for Members. As annual membership costs £10/yr, members can therefore save up to £30 over 8 concerts, even including your membership fee. Accompanied children who are 16 or under are free, whilst Students in full time education or training can attend at the same £10 rate as members. In this way we aim to: keep top class classical music available in a local setting in North Somerset, keep costs down for our members, encourage younger attendees (who represent our future audiences), and enable the YMS to afford to invite and pay for world-class artists. Our members are essential in supporting our charity to continue delivering great music locally and into the future.
